

ORC – Walk Report for Tuesday 21st June

On a lovely mid summer's evening eight members set off from the Anchor Road Carpark, Kingsclere. The circular walk, took us through the Church yard over the river, before heading up Frogs Lane and following the footpath past Porch Farm. Then turning left up an enclosed footpath, crossing the Ecchinswell Road, passing Nothing Hill. Turning left, we headed down the field boundary to the Sydmonton Road, with spectacular views from Watership Down to Cottington Hill.

Crossing the lane, we followed the path along and over Gailey Brook to Gailey Mill – built on site of the first Kingsclere mill. Crossing the Overton Road we headed east up Hollowshot Lane, before turning left up Shepherds Steps to the Recreation Ground with picturesque views both north and south. Following the path down the hill for a well-earned drink at the Bel and Dragon in Swan Street.
