

Lower and Upper Wield Walk 4th September 2022

On a cloudy, mild Sunday morning in September four members of the Ramblers set off from Lower Wield near Alresford on a circular walk, taking in views of the rolling Hampshire countryside as we went. At one point we walked part of the Three Castles Path, a 61-mile long-distance path between Windsor and Winchester.
