

Walk Report – Wednesday 2nd November 2022



Setting off from Overton on a rare dry, sunny autumn morning, four Ramblers walked past St Mary's Church and on to Overton Primary School. They followed the lane and tracks, some of which were rather muddy after recent rain. Eventually they came to the Harrow Way, an ancient track which once ran from Basingstoke to Andover and Salisbury Plain. Walking along the Harrow Way, through pretty woodland, they reached Court Drove. Following this undulating track for about a mile, they then stopped on the railway bridge to admire the views of the North Wessex Downs AONB. From there they walked back to the car park on Overton Hill, and three of the Ramblers then had lunch at Amore, an Italian Restaurant in Overton.
