Directions to start of walk	Trenchards Lane to A30, A33 to J9 then A31 (A272). Follow signs to Petersfield, left onto B3046 Cheriton. Flower Pots PH and Brewery on right hand side of the hill as you approach the village. Walk begins from the Church.
